Summary of the Ten Commandments

1. Acknowledge God as Lord, and worship him only
2. Worship him his way only, with all one's life, heart!
3. Have reverence for his Name (i.e., his reputation)
4. Keep his Day, the Lord's Day, set apart unto him

5. Honor those in rightful authority over you
6. Affirm and enhance life (i.e., vs. anger!)
7. Affirm and enhance love (i.e., vs. lust!)
8. Affirm and enhance wellbeing (i.e., vs. greed!)
9. Speak truthfully (i.e., vs. false witness and lying!)
10. Cultivate thankfulness and generosity
(vs. discontentment!)
