COMMAND (v. 2)	Go into the land.
PROMISES (v. 3-5)	Land; Victory, and God with us!
COMMAND (v. 6)	Be strong and courageous.
PROMISE (v. 6)	You shall cause them to inherit the land.
COMMAND (v. 7-8)	Only be strong and very courageous, keeping the Law
PROMISE (v. 8)	Then you will have good success!
COMMAND (v. 9)	Be strong and courageous!
PROMISE (v. 9)	God is with you!

## THE PROMISES:

The land is yours. Victory is yours.

God is with you!

As I was with Moses, so I will be with you.

You will succeed if you follow God's commands.

God is with you!

## THE COMMANDS:

Go! Be strong!

Be strong, and keep the Lord's commands!
