The LORD is my God!

2 Kings 1:7-8

He said to them, “What kind of man was he who came to meet you and told you these things?”

They answered him,
“He wore a garment of hair,
with a belt of leather about his waist.”

And he said,
“It is Elijah the Tishbite.”

1 Kings 18:21-22

And Elijah came near to all the people and said,
“How long will you go limping
between two different opinions?
If the LORD is God, follow him;
but if Baal, then follow him.”

But the people did not answer him a word.

Then Elijah said to the people,
“I, even I only, am left a prophet of the LORD,
but Baal’s prophets are 450 men.”

1 Kings 19:1-2
