Forbidden Situations:

Because...

Taking a woman's sister as a rival wife

Lying with a neighbor's wife

Offering any children to Molech = profanes God's name

Lying with a male as with a woman = it is an abomination

Lying with any animal = it is perversion

But you shall keep my statutes and my rules
and do none of these abominations,
either the native or the stranger
who sojourns among you
(for the people of the land, who were before you,
did all of these abominations,
so that the land became unclean),
lest the land vomit you out
when you make it unclean,
as it vomited out the nation
that was before you.

Leviticus 18:29

For everyone who does any of these abominations,
the persons who do them shall be cut off
from among their people.

“What is exalted among men
is an abomination in the sight of God.”

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

“All things are lawful for me,”
but not all things are helpful.

“All things are lawful for me,”
but I will not be enslaved by anything...

The body is not meant for sexual immorality,
but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body.

And God raised the Lord
and will also raise us up by his power.

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Do you not know that your bodies
are members of Christ?

Shall I then take the members of Christ
and make them members of a prostitute? Never!
Or do you not know that he who is joined
to a prostitute becomes one body with her?

For, as it is written,
“The two will become one flesh.”
But he who is joined to the Lord
becomes one spirit with him.

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Flee from sexual immorality.

Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body.

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God?

You are not your own, for you were bought with a price.

So glorify God in your body.

1 Corinthians 5:1-13

It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans, for a man has his father's wife. And you are arrogant!

Ought you not rather to mourn?

Let him who has done this be removed from among you.

For though absent in body, I am present in spirit; and as if present,

I have already pronounced judgment on the one who did such a thing.

1 Corinthians 5:1-13

When you are assembled in the name
of the Lord Jesus and my spirit is present,
with the power of our Lord Jesus,
you are to deliver this man to Satan
for the destruction of the flesh,
so that his spirit may be saved
in the day of the Lord.

Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?

Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened.

For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

1 Corinthians 5:1-13

I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people – not at all meaning the sexually immoral of this world, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world.

But now I am writing to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of brother if he is guilty of sexual immorality or greed, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or swindler – not even to eat with such a one.

For what have I to do with judging outsiders?
Is it not those inside the church whom
you are to judge?

God judges those outside.

“Purge the evil person from among you.”

Romans 1:18-32

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.

For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.

For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made.

to dishonorable passions.

For their women exchanged natural relations

And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God,

inventors of evil, disobedient to parents,
foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless.

Though they know God's decree that
those who practice such things deserve to die,
they not only do them
but give approval to those who practice them.
