Ch. 1-5 Judgment on ALL who do not repent;
Deliverance for ALL who do repent

Isaiah 5:20-21

Woe to those who call evil good and good evil,
who put darkness for light and light for darkness,
who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter!

Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes,
and shrewd in their own sight!

Isaiah 2:2-3a

It shall come to pass in the latter days
that the mountain of the house of the LORD
shall be established as the highest of the mountains,
and shall be lifted up above the hills;
and all the nations shall flow to it,
and many peoples shall come, and say:

“Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD,
to the house of the God of Jacob,
that he may teach us his ways
and that we may walk in his paths.”

Isaiah 2:3b-5

For out of Zion shall go the law,
and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
He shall judge between the nations,
and shall decide disputes for many peoples;
and they shall beat their swords into plowshares,
and their spears into pruning hooks;
nation shall not lift up sword against nation,
neither shall they learn war anymore.

O house of Jacob, come,
let us walk in the light of the LORD.

Isaiah 4:2-4

In that day the branch of the LORD
shall be beautiful and glorious,
and the fruit of the land shall be
the pride and honor of the survivors of Israel.

And he who is left in Zion and remains in Jerusalem
will be called holy, everyone who has been recorded
for life in Jerusalem, when the Lord shall have
washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion
and cleansed the bloodstains of Jerusalem
from its midst by a spirit of judgment
and by a spirit of burning.

Isaiah 4:5-6

Then the LORD will create over the whole site
of Mount Zion and over her assemblies
a cloud by day, and smoke and the shining
of a flaming fire by night;
for over all the glory there will be a canopy.

There will be a booth for shade
by day from the heat,
and for a refuge and a shelter
from the storm and rain.

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign.
Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son,
and shall call his name Immanuel.

Isaiah 8:7-10

Therefore, behold, the Lord is bringing up against them the waters of the River, mighty and many, the king of Assyria and all his glory.

And it will rise over all its channels and go over all its banks, ⁸ and it will sweep on into Judah, it will overflow and pass on, reaching even to the neck, and its outspread wings will fill the breadth of your land, O Immanuel...

Take counsel together, but it will come to nothing; speak a word, but it will not stand, for God is with us [*“Immanuel”*].

Isaiah 9:1-5

But there will be no gloom
for her who was in anguish.

In the former time he brought into contempt
the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali,
but in the latter time he has made glorious
the way of the sea, the land beyond the Jordan,
Galilee of the nations.

The people who walked in darkness
have seen a great light;
those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness,
on them has light shined...

Isaiah 9:6-7

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given;
and the government shall be upon his shoulder,
and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor,
Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Of the increase of his government
and of peace there will be no end,
on the throne of David and over his kingdom,
to establish it and to uphold it with justice
and with righteousness from this time forth
and forevermore.

The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Isaiah 11:1-10

There shall come forth a shoot
from the stump of Jesse,
and a branch from his roots
shall bear fruit.

And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him,
the Spirit of wisdom and understanding,
the Spirit of counsel and might,
the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.
And his delight shall be
in the fear of the LORD.

Isaiah 11:1-10

He shall not judge by what his eyes see,
or decide disputes by what his ears hear,
but with righteousness he shall judge the poor,
and decide with equity for the meek of the earth;
and he shall strike the earth with the rod
of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips
he shall kill the wicked.

Righteousness shall be the belt of his waist,
and faithfulness the belt of his loins.

Isaiah 11:1-10

The wolf shall dwell with the lamb,
and the leopard shall lie down with the young goat,
and the calf and the lion
and the fattened calf together;
and a little child shall lead them.

The cow and the bear shall graze;

Isaiah 19:23-25

In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and Assyria will come into Egypt, and Egypt into Assyria, and the Egyptians will worship with the Assyrians.

In that day Israel will be the third with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing in the midst of the earth, whom the LORD of hosts has blessed, saying, “Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel my inheritance.”

Isaiah 25:6-9

On this mountain the LORD of hosts
will make for all peoples a feast of rich food,
a feast of well-aged wine,
of rich food full of marrow,
of aged wine well refined.
