

Jeremiah 31:31-32

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when I will make a new covenant
with the house of Israel and the house of Judah,
not like the covenant that I made with their fathers
on the day when I took them by the hand
to bring them out of the land of Egypt,
my covenant that they broke,
though I was their husband,
declares the LORD.”

A NEW COVENANT ???

1. A binding agreement between two parties

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Like a contract,
but much more than a mere contract!

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2. Permanent and inviolable

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God condescends to us, that we may know him and enjoy the blessings of relationship with him. And God constrains himself, making promises to us and remaining absolutely faithful to those promises!

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ABRAHAM:	the promise of Blessing

Genesis 12:1-3

Now the LORD said to Abram,
“Go from your country and your kindred
and your father’s house
to the land that I will show you.
And I will make of you a great nation,
and I will bless you and make your name great,
so that you will be a blessing.
I will bless those who bless you,
and him who dishonors you I will curse,
and in you all the families of the earth
shall be blessed.”

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ADAM:	the promise of Seed
NOAH:	the promise of Common Grace
ABRAHAM:	the promise of Blessing, via Promised Land and Promised Seed

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<u>Land</u> :	A place (i.e., the place of blessing)
<u>Seed</u> :	A people (to whom blessing will flow) A person (through whom blessing will flow)

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MOSES:	promise with conditions (OLD)

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- Wall of cleanness (between God and the nations)

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- Wall of holiness (between God and Israel)
- Wall of cleanness (between God and the nations)
- Infusing the whole, the need for righteousness

Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Hear, O Israel:

The LORD our God, the LORD is one.

You shall love the LORD your God
with all your heart and with all your soul
and with all your might.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9

And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

“Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?”

And he said to him,

“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

This is the great and first commandment.

And the second is like it:

You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

On these two commandments

depend all the Law and the Prophets.”

“The days are coming,” declares the LORD,

And I will give them one heart,

I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh
and give them a heart of flesh,
that they may walk in my statutes
and keep my rules and obey them.

And they shall be my people,
and I will be their God.

Ezekiel 36:24-27

I will take you from the nations

John 3:3-8

Jesus answered him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God...

“Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.”

John 3:3-8

“Do not marvel that I said to you,
‘You must be born again.’

The wind blows where it wishes,
and you hear its sound,
but you do not know where it comes from
or where it goes.

“So it is with everyone
who is born of the Spirit.”

John 3:14-21

As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness,
so must the Son of Man be lifted up,
that whoever believes in him
may have eternal life.

For God so loved the world,
that he gave his only Son,
that whoever believes in him
should not perish
but have eternal life.

John 3:14-21

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

And this is the judgment:
the light has come into the world,
and people loved the darkness rather than the light
because their deeds were evil.

Galatians 3:13-14

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us – for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree” – so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.

Revelation 5:9-10

And they sang a new song:

“You are worthy to take the scroll
and to open its seals, because you were slain,
and with your blood you purchased men for God
from every tribe and language
and people and nation.

“You have made them to be a kingdom
and priests to serve our God,
and they will reign on the earth.”

Jeremiah 31:34

“And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor
and each his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’
for they shall all know me,
from the least of them to the greatest,
declares the LORD.

“For I will forgive their iniquity,
and I will remember their sin
no more.”

A NEW COVENANT ???

1. God's law within us, written on our hearts
2. He our God, and we his people
3. All God's people will know Him
4. God will forgive our sins
and shall remember them no more

John 17:3

“And this is eternal life,
that they know you the only true God,
and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.”

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- A new knowledge (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit)

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Pressing down	God himself our Mediator
Lifting up	God anoints ALL his people
Pushing out	God present among his people

- A new assurance!
- A new commission (with a new power!)

2 Corinthians 3:1-6

Are we beginning to commend ourselves again?
Or do we need, as some do,
letters of recommendation to you, or from you?
You yourselves are our letter of recommendation,
written on our hearts, to be known and read by all.
And you show that you are a letter from Christ
delivered by us, written not with ink
but with the Spirit of the living God,
not on tablets of stone
but on tablets of human hearts.

2 Corinthians 3:1-6

Such is the confidence that we have
through Christ toward God.

Not that we are sufficient in ourselves
to claim anything as coming from us,
but our sufficiency is from God,
who has made us competent
to be ministers of a new covenant,
not of the letter but of the Spirit.

John 13:34-35

“A new commandment I give to you,
that you love one another:
just as I have loved you,
you also are to love one another.
By this all people will know
that you are my disciples,
if you have love for one another.”

1 John 2:7-9

“Beloved, I am writing you no new commandment, but an old commandment that you had from the beginning.

The old commandment is the word that you have heard.

At the same time, it is a new commandment that I am writing to you, which is true in him and in you, because the darkness is passing away and the true light is already shining.

1 Peter 4:8

Above all,
keep loving one another earnestly,
since love covers a multitude of sins.

Romans 13:9-10:

The commandments,

“You shall not commit adultery,

You shall not murder, You shall not steal,

You shall not covet,” and any other commandment,
are summed up in this word:

“You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

Love does no wrong to a neighbor;

therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

1 John 2:15-20

Do not love the world or the things in the world.
If anyone loves the world,
the love of the Father is not in him.

For all that is in the world –
the desires of the flesh
and the desires of the eyes
and pride in possessions –
is not from the Father but is from the world.

1 John 2:15-20

And the world is passing away along with its desires,
but whoever does the will of God
abides forever.

But you have been anointed by the Holy One,

2 Corinthians 4:5-18

For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness,"
has shone in our hearts to give the light
of the knowledge of the glory of God
in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:5-18

But we have this treasure in jars of clay,
to show that the surpassing power
belongs to God and not to us.

We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed;
perplexed, but not driven to despair;
persecuted, but not forsaken;
struck down, but not destroyed;
always carrying in the body the death of Jesus,
so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested
in our bodies.

2 Corinthians 4:5-18

So we do not lose heart.
