The Second Missionary Journey: Corinth

1. How is Paul's visit to Corinth (v. 4) similar to his visits to Thessalonica (17:2), Berea (17:10), and Ephesus (v. 19)?

2. What did it mean to reason or argue for the Gospel? Does anyone do this today? If not, why not?

3. To what does Paul devote himself (v. 5)? To what do you devote yourself?

4. What significant decision does Paul make and why (vv. 5-6)?

5. What does God promise Paul in Corinth, and what is Paul's response (vv. 9-11)?

6. How much time does Paul spend in Corinth and what does he do (v. 11)? How does this differ from the way evangelists operate today?

7. How does God keep his promise (vv. 12-17)? Have unexpected circumstances been used by God in keeping his promises to you?

8. Why doesn't Gallio take the case of the Jews against Paul seriously (vv. 12-16)? What kind of a precedent is established which will recur throughout the rest of the Book of Acts?
